A maximum of two persons may meet with a K&C professional in our boardroom, you will be greeted at the front reception area which now has an acrylic screen in place - masks, gloves, hand sanitizer and personal pens are available. We have also implemented extra sanitizing measures on high touch surfaces such as door handles, counters, and boardroom table. Please under no circumstances if you are experiencing symptoms or in a period of self-isolation do not attend our office or transport physical records.

We have implemented a secure electronic means to supply information such as records at no additional cost. A call to the office and we can provide you instructions as to how to do that. Should you need to drop physical records our office remains open. Our policy is to allow all records dropped off at the front desk to sit for a three-day period prior to opening.

These have certainly been difficult and uncertain times and we appreciate your patience as we attempt to adapt our operations. Our primary goal is to ensure we have taken necessary precautions so that our staff, clients, and our communities are kept safe and further spread of this illness is stopped, without our clients noticing significant disruption in services.
